Day 1 October 26, Friday: Depart for Italy

Depart Minneapolis - St. Paul International Airport for our flight to Rome. Complimentary meals and beverages will be served in-flight. (D,B)

Day 2 October 27, Saturday: Welcome to Rome!

Arrive at Rome's Leonardo da Vinci Airport, proceed through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and a Peter's Way tour manager will meet us as we exit Customs. Continue to Rome for hotel check-in. Independent lunch. Remainder of the day at leisure. Independent Dinner. Overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B)

Day 3 October 28, Sunday: Optional: St. Peter's Basilica | Tour of Imperial Rome

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. Morning at leisure with option to attend Mass at St. Peter's Basilica and the Noon Papal Blessing at St. Peter's Square. Independent Lunch. This afternoon, visit the Church of St. Peter in Chains to see the original chains in which St. Peter was brought captive to Rome and the statue of Moses, one of Michelangelo's greatest masterpieces. Continue to the ancient Roman Forum and see the Arch of Titus and the Arch of Constantine. Proceed to the outside of the Colosseum for a fascinating explanation of its history. We will see the white marble monument of King Victor Emmanuel II, often called the "wedding cake"; and the Trajan Column and Market (ancient Roman equivalent of a department store). Independent Dinner. Overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B)

Day 4 October 29, Monday: At Leisure in Rome | Private Visit to the Vatican Museums | Together In Hope Choir Musical Spiritual Elevation in the Sistine Chapel

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. Full day at leisure. This is an opportunity to explore the sights, sounds and tastes of Rome all on your own! Treat yourself to a leisurely multi-course lunch in a quaint trattoria. Visit the Pantheon or the Borghese Gallery. Experience the beautiful and lively Piazza Navona with some time to browse through the artists' stalls. Enjoy a "tartufo" (Rome's cherished ice cream) at the Gelateria "Tre Scalini". Throw a coin in the Trevi Fountain. Rome is ours! Around 5:00 pm, we will have a private visit to one of the greatest art collections in the world: the Vatican Museums. The Vatican Museums contain masterpieces of painting, sculpture and other works of art collected by the popes through the centuries. The Museums include several monumental works of art, such as the Sistine Chapel, the Chapel of Beato Angelico, the Raphael Rooms and Loggia and the Borgia Apartment. The Pinacoteca, or Picture Gallery, was inaugurated on October 27, 1932 in the building especially constructed by the architect Luca Beltrami for Pius XI. It is connected to the Museum complex (at the entrance of the Quattro Cancelli) by an elegant portico. The Christian, Profane and Missionary-Ethnological Museum contains a collection of artistic and archaeological objects, some of an ethnological nature, that were once housed in the Lateran Palace. The Collection of Modern Religious Art was added to the Museums in 1973. Our tour concludes in the Sistine Chapel, the private chapel of the popes, where Michelangelo best expressed his genius in monumental frescoes. After our guided visit, enjoy a Musical Spiritual Elevation in the Sistine Chapel by the Together In Hope Choir. Return transfer to hotel included. Overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B)

Day 5 October 30, Tuesday: Excursion to Assisi | Sites of Francis and St. Clare

Buffet breakfast at our hotel, then depart Rome for a full day excursion to Assisi (two-hour drive). As we drive through the picturesque Umbria region, you will soon see the town dedicated to St. Francis perched on a mountaintop. Upon arrival, our local guide will take us to explore the Basilica complex, which is actually composed of two churches built one atop the other. Beneath both churches is the crypt that houses the tomb of St. Francis. The lower Basilica is richly decorated with beautiful stained glass windows and paintings by some of the most important artists of the 13th and 14th centuries. The upper Basilica is adorned with monumental frescoes, painted by Giotto, which depict scenes from the life of St. Francis. Included lunch in Assisi. After lunch, we will visit the Basilica of St. Clare dedicated to the first heroine of the Franciscan movement. Continue to Santa Maria degli Angeli, a great Basilica that encloses the "Porziuncula" around which the first Franciscan community was centered and the place where Clare received the habit from Francis. We will also see the Capella Del Transito, which marks the spot where St. Francis died, and the statue of St. Francis in the courtyard where thornless roses bloom. On our return to Rome, a stop will be made for independent dinner. Overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B,L)

Day 6 October 31, Wednesday: Morning at Leisure | Inaugural Concert of the 17th International Festival of Sacred Music and Art

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. Morning at leisure with option to attend the General Papal Audience held weekly in St. Peter's Square. Independent Lunch. Afternoon at leisure. This is a good time to explore more of the sights of Rome. Hardy Ambassadors may want to attempt to climb the 330 stairs (or take the elevator) to the top of St. Peter's for an unparalleled view of Vatican City and Rome. 9:00pm Inauguration of the 17th International Festival of Sacred Music and Art. Together In Hope Choir will present the world premiere of a new composition dedicated to Pope Francis at this Inaugural Concert held at St Paul Outside-the-Walls. Independent Dinner. Overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B)

Day 7 November 1, Thursday: Papal Basilicas of Rome | Spiritual Elevation at St. Peter's Basilica

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. We begin our day with a guided visit to the magnificent Basilica of St. Paul. After last night's performance at this extraordinary Basilica, today we will explore its interior more deeply. Surrounding the nave are the medallions of each pope, from St. Peter to Pope Francis. Our tour continues to the Cathedral of St. John Lateran, the first Christian church to be consecrated. The Basilica was founded by the Emperor Constantine in the 4th century and was home to the popes for many years prior to the present Vatican residence. Our morning tour concludes with a visit to the Basilica of St. Mary Major, one of the four major Basilicas of Rome. Explore the impressive interior with its remarkable mosaics in the nave depicting scenes from the Old Testament. Two Christian treasures in this Basilica include a relic of the manger from Bethlehem and the painting of the Blessed Mother known as the Salus Populi Romani, (The Salvation of the Roman People). Tradition attributes the painting to St. Luke. This image had been brought back from the Holy Land by St. Helena, mother of the Emperor Constantine. Independent lunch. Afternoon transfer to St. Peter's Basilica for 3:45pm Spiritual Elevation and Solemn Mass with Together In Hope Choir participating. Farewell dinner at a restaurant in Rome. Overnight at our hotel in Rome. (B,D)

Day 8 November 2, Friday: Return from Rome

After breakfast at the hotel, we will be transferred to Rome's Leonardo da Vinci Airport for our return flight home. Arrive on the same day. (B)



PAYMENT: Deposits and insurance payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order or debit/credit card. A discount of \$100.00 per person will apply for payments made entirely by personal check, money order or certified bank check. Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to increase package price or reduce services accordingly should there be an escalation in the Euro valuation over the U.S. Dollar in excess of 3% from print date. If final payment is not received by the balance deadline, Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to cancel your reservation. If for any reason payment is received within 21 days of departure, a charge for express mailing of final documents will apply. A \$50.00 late payment fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Personal checks will not be accepted within 30 days of departure. If the bank has returned a personal check, a \$25.00 processing fee will apply and subsequent payments must be made in the form of money order, certified bank check or debit/credit card.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS: From the time your deposit is received up to 130 days prior to departure, there is a \$250.00 nonrefundable cancellation fee per person. From 129 to 100 days prior to departure, there is a \$350.00 nonrefundable cancellation fee per person. From 99 days prior to departure up to the day of departure, there is a nonrefundable cancellation fee of 100% of all payments made per person including departure taxes & fuel surcharges, single supplement, deviation fees, travel insurance payments and any other costs incurred. Travel insurance is offered as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons such as illness or injury, please see TRAVEL INSURANCE. Travel insurance payments are nonrefundable upon receipt. Tour participation is nontransferable. Names cannot be transferred on reservations or airline tickets. Refund requests can only be honored when submitted in writing to Peter's Way Tours. All refund requests are subject to cancellation restrictions as set forth above. No refund will be made for any accommodations or services included in the tour that you do not use.

LATE RESERVATIONS: A \$25.00 late reservation fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for bookings received after the deposit deadline. All space is subject to availability and cannot be guaranteed past the deposit deadline noted on brochure.

PASSPORT | TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: All participants must have a valid passport. **U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months**, subsequent to return date. Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current requirements. It is solely the passenger's responsibility to ensure that all documents needed are completed and current. Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for lack of current and valid entry documents.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: Round trip on **Delta or American Airlines from Minneapolis St. Paul International Airport**. Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Departure taxes & fuel surcharges are estimated. They are determined solely by the airlines and are subject to increase prior to ticketing (approximately 30 days prior to departure).

AIRLINE SEATING: Under group airline reservations/contracts, the airlines will provide a block of seats for the group. Individual requests for seating preferences can only be made at time of check-in. Peter's Way cannot submit seating preferences as we cannot guarantee that any or all requests will be honored. If you require specific seating as a condition of your travel, it is suggested that you book your airfare individually and purchase the land only package. Upgrades to premium economy, business class, or first class may be available but oftentimes airlines will not allow the upgrades until time of ticketing (approximately 30 days prior to departure). Group reservations may not be accessible online for advance check-in/boarding passes/seat assignments. Airline guidelines vary. Please contact our office for specific details.

LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: Land Only packages do not include any portion of the group airfare. **All airline tickets will be your responsibility to book independently.** A passenger choosing the land only portion of the package (**\$2,320.00 per person sharing a twin room at Hotel Cardinal, \$2,680 at Hotel Michelangelo**) must notify Peter's Way Tours, in writing, 100 days prior to date of departure or a penalty fee will be assessed. Please be advised, passenger(s) opting for the Land Only package or who are deviating from the group itinerary will be responsible for their own transfers to/from hotel/airport. However, if you arrive at the same time or earlier than your group, you are welcome to join the group on the bus. Additionally, if you purchase your own air transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel your package for any reason, Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare.

DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES: Peter's Way Tours is pleased to assist clients with changes in itineraries. All deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 90 days prior to departure. Deviation fee will apply plus an airline change fee per person. Your routing and dates requested will determine if a difference in airfare will also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. Please contact our office for detailed information.

TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE: Round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package. Porterage of one piece of luggage throughout your tour at hotels is also included.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: Price per person is based on two persons sharing twin bedded rooms with private facilities in hotels throughout your tour. Matrimonial (full) bedded rooms are subject to availability and must be requested. Triple rooms may be available but we discourage triple room accommodations because they are normally not spacious and there is no discount for triple occupancy. Triple rooms usually are regular twin or matrimonial (full) bedded rooms with a rollaway bed added. Single rooms are limited but may be requested at time of booking for an additional charge of **\$500.00**. While single rooms provide privacy, they are often smaller than twin bedded rooms and may be located away from the group. We will make every effort (if you so desire) to match you with a same gender roommate when we receive your application, but we do not guarantee a roommate can be matched. If a single room must be assigned due to your roommate's cancellation, incompatibility or for any other reason (even at the last moment or while on tour), we must charge you the tour's single supplement or pro-rated amount.

MEALS: Buffet breakfast daily plus a group lunch in Assisi, and a farewell dinner at a restaurant in Rome, including mineral water and wine.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities are not included in your tour package. For good work, we recommend 4,00 Euro per person per day for your tour manager; 2,00 Euro per person per day for your bus driver; 1,50 Euro per person for a local guide when applicable. Tips for your tour manager and bus driver are normally given as a group at the end of the tour. Other gratuities are usually handled individually. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the program rate. Although service charges at the hotels are included, it is customary to leave 1,00 Euro per person for your waiter following dinner at the hotel and 1,00 Euro per person per day for housekeeping.
